

City of Anaheim Financial Support to Schools

The City of Anaheim has a long history of collaboration and partnership with school districts operating within the boundaries of the City. As part of these partnerships, the City often invests significant financial resources on an annual basis to provide supplemental support to Anaheim schools.

The charts below provide a summary of the services the City provides to school districts that serve Anaheim students. In total, these services represent an estimated \$5.7 million annually in City financial support to local schools.
