SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION TO PURCHASE A FLIR CAMERA SERVICE
MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council, by Motion, waive Council Policy 4.0 and authorize the Purchasing Agent to issue a master agreement to FLIR Surveillance Inc. (FLIR), in the amount of \$59,276.25, for service maintenance to the FLIR Star Safire 380 HD camera system for a one-year period, with four one-year optional renewals and authorize the Purchasing Agent to exercise the renewal options, subject to budget appropriations.

DISCUSSION:

The Police Department Air Support Unit requires a service maintenance agreement for the FLIR Star Safire 380 HD airborne high-definition color camera with infrared thermal imager, low-light amplification imager, and laser range finder. This camera system provides high quality color or infrared images of ground situations from extended distances and altitudes while providing detailed, real-time information to multiple command centers. The system's capabilities enable incident commanders to assess hazards before sending emergency personnel into harm's way.

The Police Department would like to enter into this service maintenance agreement with the exclusive provider FLIR, which includes general maintenance and repair at the FLIR authorized service center, two service visits by FLIR technicians at the Police Department heliport, free use of a loaner camera during repairs of our unit, 100% of the cost for any parts or labor required for all repairs or preventative maintenance, all shipping costs, and priority service turnaround time. Maintaining this system in good working order will continue to provide law enforcement, fire safety, health and other disciplines with a platform that provides advanced response capabilities and sophisticated command and control ability.

The term of the agreement shall be for a one-year period with up to four one-year renewal options. Pricing for the renewal period will be negotiated, based on the current market conditions at the time of renewal.

IMPACT ON BUDGET:

Sufficient funds are available in the Police Department's Fiscal Year 2020/21 restricted Narcotic Asset Forfeiture Fund. Funding for subsequent year renewals will be subject to Council's approval of budget appropriations.
