RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council, by Resolution:

1. Ratify the submission of the grant application and authorize the Chief of Police, or his designee, to accept a grant award on behalf of the City of Anaheim from the California Highway Patrol to participate in the FY 2022/23 Cannabis Tax Refund Grant Program; and
2. Authorize the Chief of Police, or his designee, to execute all grant agreements and other required documents, and take any actions necessary to implement such grant agreements and other required documents; and increase the Police Department's FY 2022/23 revenue and expenditure appropriations by \$85,000.

DISCUSSION:

The California Highway Patrol has approved the City's application for funding under the FY 2022/23 Cannabis Tax Fund Grant Program in the amount of \$85,000. This grant provides funding to cover overtime costs, which will enable the Anaheim Police Department to provide public education and outreach, DUI/DUID enforcement efforts, and provide officer training focused on detecting and removing impaired drivers from the roadway.

IMPACT ON BUDGET:

FY 2022/23 revenue and expenditure appropriations will be increased by \$85,000 in the Police Department's Restricted Law Enforcement Grant Fund. There is no local match requirement.
