HOTEL INCENTIVE PROGRAM

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council, by Resolution, rescind the Resolution No. 2015-202, which established the Hotel Incentive Program.

DISCUSSION:

On June 16, 2015, the City Council of the City of Anaheim approved and adopted Resolution No. 2015-202, establishing the Hotel Incentive Program to bring four diamond quality hotels to Anaheim. In accordance with the Hotel Incentive Program, the City Council approved and the City entered into three Operating Covenant Agreements related to the development and operation of Luxury Hotels of 580 rooms at 1700 South Harbor, 634 rooms at 1030 West Katella Avenue and approximately 700 rooms to the north of the Disneyland Hotel; thereby, creating the desired number of luxury rooms within the City.

At the December 13, 2016 City Council meeting, both Mayor Pro Tem Kring and Mayor Tait requested that staff bring forth an item for City Council consideration which would terminate the Hotel Incentive Program. Accordingly, the proposed Resolution would terminate the Hotel Incentive Program.
